The Curator shall:

- discover and collect materials illustrating the local history for incorporation in the Historical Collection of the Westbury Memorial Public Library, so that they can be displayed and made available to students and the general public.
- hold meetings, lectures, and discussions and engage in any other activities promoting the study of local history.
- attend monthly meetings of the Historical Society of the Westburys.
- assist users with inquiries regarding the collection.
- managing volunteers who assist with the collection.
