### Job Description and Responsibilities:

This position is 5 hours a week and follows the academic year schedule.

- Monitor bustling Library usage after school: supervise Middle School students to ensure a
  respectful and productive environment. This includes communicating with parents, babysitters and
  elementary school students.
- Maintain an inclusive, safe and friendly environment
- Shelve library materials
- Process and catalog new materials and prepare them for shelving
- Maintain the physical appearance of library to ensure it is welcoming and tidy
- Circulate books (e.g. check in library books and assist patrons with library check out)

- Working on a Master's degree in Library and Information Science from an ALA-accredited university (preferably)
- Experience working in a school library or with youth
- Fluency in French and/or Spanish is preferred but not required
- Creativity, curiosity, and attention to detail
- Strong organizational and communication skills
- Ability to work collaboratively and independently in a dynamic school environment
- Passion for reading and books
- Appreciation for working with young people
- Sense of humor, flexibility, and interpersonal skills
