PURPOSE & OVERVIEW

Since its founding in 1956, the Seminar on the Acquisition of Latin American Library Materials, SALALM, has provided the only national and international forum focused on Latin American studies research librarianship, library collections, and services.

The SALALM Conference Attendance Scholarship, offering up to \$2,000 and a one-year membership in the organization, is designed to promote professional and leadership development in Latin American, Caribbean, and Iberian Studies librarianship. The scholarship provides the opportunity to attend the upcoming SALALM annual conference, scheduled for May 26-29, 2025, in New York City. The event will be hosted by NYU's Center for Latin American and Caribbean Studies (CLACS) in collaboration with Columbia University, CUNY, and the NYPL's Stephen A. Schwarzman Building.

This award is open to master's candidates enrolled in ALA-accredited (or equivalent) programs in library, information, or archival studies, as well as early-career librarians in the U.S. and Canada.
